D. THEME

Forty Steps40階段

located in Jungang-dong中央洞, Junggu中區, Busan釜山

Around 1407, when Busan port was opened to Japan, the current Choryang草梁 area was designated as a Japanese residential area called Weigwan倭館. At that time, few Japanese resents lived there. However, from the later part of the 19th century, the number of Japanese residents increased rapidly used the current Donggwang-dong東光洞 area as the main street.




When the Korean War broke in 1950, many refugees were driven into Busan and most settled temporarily in the hilly

section of the Donggwang-dong area. This little area is really just two short streets, would have been an important economic and social area for refugees and residents alike. At the end of one of these streets is a set of Forty Steps leading from the lower street to the higher-up residential areas. These are the Forty Steps and it is here that refugees would pass to try and find work and food to survive and here they ended up gathering to try to find any information about missing family members. A black market about dollars and relief supplies were also in this Forty Steps. To relieve some joy and sorrow in our past life as well as recollect those times, it was newly fixed and this monument was installed. Its monument says the lyric of "Gyeongsangdo Agassi" and the history of Forty Steps.

The Forty Steps Cultural Tourism Theme Street, which has joys and sorrows of in the 1950's through 1960's life like a big nostalgia, was formed as a new tourist attraction. Some railroads, traffic lights, marble roads, granite crossbeams, the Maronie street trees, some electric poles were installed to feel past times with the theme of old Busan station building, railroads, seaway as a symbol of Busan harbor as well as Busan Station.

The site chosen at the workshop include streets and areas around Forty Steps. Rehabilitation scheme on Forty Steps as a significant modern historic place will be investigated with the method for preserving and rehabilitating the historic values and relics by redesign of building, street and landscape around. The Forty Steps Cultural Tourism Theme Street in front of Forty Steps can be the one of streets redesigned by your scheme.



F. PROGRAM

Design Workshop : 7. 25(Mon.) ~ 7. 30(Sat.)

In the beginning of the workshop, there will be an organized site-visit for the participants to understand the site in its context. Before the site-visit, the participants will receive the geological, historical and cultural information of the site. After site-visits, the individuals need to come up with his or her own definition of the key problems. Then, they will form design teams by gathering persons with similar definition of the key problems. Each will investigate design solutions and present a conceptual design at the last day of the workshop. The final presentation will consist of drawings on boards and a scaled model.

Special lectures on theories and historical backgrounds of the site and the program will be given during the workshop.

Post-Workshop Tour : 7. $31(Sun.) \sim 8.6(Sat.)$

Post-workshop tour will give participants opportunities to visit a number of Korean cities and experience Korean tradition and culture. The tour will be organized during the workshop. A separate application and fee is required for the tour.
